Overview

To help meet the airport's growing needs and prepare for the future, we're expanding the aircraft parking areas known as aprons in three key locations:

- The Remote Apron expansion is located to the west of the Air Traffic Control tower
- The Southern Apron expansion is located at the southern end of the terminal
- The Northern Apron expansion is located at the northern end of the terminal.

These upgrades will add more aircraft parking spaces at the terminal, making it easier to manage plane movements, especially during busy times and overnight. This will help things run more smoothly and make travel more convenient for our passengers and airline partners.

What will it deliver?

The Apron Expansion Projects will create up to nine additional aircraft parking areas at the northern and southern ends of the terminal.

More parking bays for planes will help ease bottlenecks during busy peak periods and deliver more efficient scheduling options including overnight parking for early morning departures. It also means our infrastructure can support our aviation network vision to directly connect Adelaide to 39 international destinations by 2050.

What will happen during construction?

The upgrade work is being done in stages to help reduce any changes and disruptions to our customers.

Work on the remote apron is underway and you might notice this if you park your car at the long term (P3) carpark.

The southern boundary of the P3 car park has been moved to accommodate the new remote apron.

To make room for the project, we've made some changes to our long-term car parking options including opening a new car park (our P2 Outdoor).

Construction work will be scheduled to minimise disruptions to passengers, the airport community, nearby residents and to aircraft operations.

We'll keep you up to date with any other changes and our staff are always happy to assist whenever you need it.
