Adelaide Airport records 15.3% growth in international passengers for Q2 FY17

Continued strong growth in international passengers of 15.3% underpinned a 2.7% increase in total passenger numbers for Q1 FY17 compared to the prior corresponding period.

The commencement of China Southern from the 13th of December contributed an additional 3,465 seats for the quarter and will contribute a further 16,500 seats in Quarter 3 of the financial year. The service is the first between Adelaide and mainland China and is a major boost to South Australia's tourism economy.

Travel to Bali continued to grow with passenger traffic up 30.9% on the prior corresponding period across the two carriers that service the route.

Domestic passengers grew 1.2% to 1.86 million for the quarter led by passenger increases on markets of Cairns (+8.9%), Canberra (+7.5%) and Brisbane (+1.5%). The Jetstar Sunshine Coast service flew for its first full quarter increasing capacity to Queensland by 13,800 seats.

On the final day of December Adelaide Airport reached the milestone of 8 million passengers in a calendar year with a total of 8,007,000 passengers passing through the terminal in 2016.
