5.0 AIRPORT UPDATE

5.1 Adelaide Airport Limited Report – tabled with the following noted;
Air Asia X will commence on 31st October 2013. Works to expand the apron at the southern end of the terminal have received provisional approval with enabling works to commence in December and major works in early January.

5.2 Property and Development and Land Use Report – tabled with the following noted;

A Merit Use Application under the Airport Master Plan (2009) has been processed during July, 2013 for a “Cavalía” event, intended to be held during October, 2013 to November, 2013. Consultation has been held with the State and Local Governments, including a meeting held with West Beach residents on 30th July, 2013, with conditional support given by the City of West Torrens and Department of Planning Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI). Conditional Merit Consent is being considered

by AAL covering specified traffic management, environmental and statutory obligations.

Mike Shaw added his considerations from an Air Traffic prospective regarding the height/flight paths etc.

5.3 Environment Report – tabled with the following noted;

Chris Griffiths referred to the Environment Report and acknowledged the department on receiving Level 1 Airports Council International Carbon Accreditation for Parafield and Adelaide Airport.

5.4 Planning Co-ordination Forum Report- tabled with the following noted;

Ministerial Development Plan Amendment covering the Riverbank area north of North Terrace and west of King William Road – currently on public consultation till 10 September 2013.

Development Proposal – 9-14 North Terrace, Adelaide (former Heaven Night Club)
A development application has been lodged with the Development Assessment Commission for an 18 storey office tower fronting North Terrace and a 13 storey hotel on West Terrace. The proposed development will exceed the airport building heights currently prescribed in the Adelaide (City) Development Plan

Robert mentioned someone he knows lives on Ansett Avenue and had to go to AAL for height approval. Brenton advised that certain areas close to Airport need referral. 3 metres plus structures will be referred to the Commonwealth.

Airservices are have fixed monitors in Brooklyn Park, Netley, West Beach and Glenelg North – all residential. Chairman and Chris Griffiths met with a noise complainer which was suggested as a turbo prop aircraft at 2am and 3am on certain occasions.
