Construction is underway.....

Construction has started on the \$165m expansion of Adelaide Airport's domestic and international terminal - improving our international arrivals and departures experience and creating more retail and dining options for all travelers.



Construction Update

- Civil works have commenced within the main site including building platform preparation.
- Preliminary demolition work has started along the northern pier of the existing terminal.
- Piling has commenced

Current Customer impact

- Minimal impact at this time, aside from additional construction vehicle traffic.
- No impact on terminal operations. Check in and boarding times as recommended by your airline.

Project Milestones

- Site established: July 2018
- Construction started: August 2018
