Terminal changes coming.....

Construction is progressing on schedule with works moving inside the terminal in coming months. The new build section is well advanced with roofing and façade installation nearing completion.



Latest update

- Construction of the new build area is progressing well with completion of façade and roofing installation within the next month.
- Construction works adjacent Atura Circuit continue towards completion of paving and public forecourt areas.
- You will notice some changes to retail including the relocation into temporary sites of Hudson Coffee, Mac and Seed. The following stores will close: Smiggle, Kikki K, Victoria Secret and Blue Illusion. We look forward to announcing a number of our new retail stores over the coming months.
- Additional hoardings will be installed inside the terminal in late September 2019 in the retail concourse.
- The play space adjacent Hudsons Coffee will be closed temporarily and a new play space will be built as part of the expanded retail concourse opening in 2020.

Current customer impact

- Customers will continue to see building works inside the terminal.
- Construction activity will result in a reduction in the width of the concourse and minor changes to gate lounge access. We recommend allowing an extra couple of minutes to reach your boarding gate.
- Check in and boarding times are as recommended by your airline.

Construction Facts

- More than 200 workers currently on site with more than 200,000 man hours on the project up to the end of July 2019
- 1,800 tonnes of steel installed
- 4300 cubic metres of concrete poured
- 2600 square metres of precast concrete installed

- Façade to be completed October 2019
- First stages of concourse refurbishment including new retail spaces to be completed early 2020
