## First new retailers to open this month

#### New retail concourse will open to the public on 26<sup>th</sup> February



#### Latest update

- Construction of the new northern build is complete and the first section of the new retail concourse will open to the public on 26<sup>th</sup> February.
- Exciting new retailers opening in this first phase opening are Penfolds Wine Bar & Kitchen, Precinct Adelaide Kitchen, Soul Origin, Boost Juice, Lego Kaboom and Airport Pharmacy. More details at <u>Retail News</u>
- The Coopers Bar, along with a number of other existing retailers, have relocated into pop-up outlets while refurbishment of the retail areas continues.
- Changes to hoardings in the terminal can be expected in late February into March as refurbishment of the existing terminal concourse continues.
- New airline and other tenant offices are opening in the new northern expansion.

#### **Current customer impact**

- Exciting new retail outlets will soon be available on the northern concourse adjacent to Gates 14-16.
- Customers will continue to see building works and changes to retail inside the terminal.
- Construction activity will result in a reduction in the width of the concourses and changes to gate lounge access in some areas. We recommend allowing an extra couple of minutes to reach your boarding gate.
- Check in and boarding times are as recommended by your airline.



#### **Construction Facts**

- More than 150 workers currently on site with more than 410,000 man hours on the project up to the end **of January 2020**
- 1,800 tonnes of steel installed
- 4300 cubic metres of concrete poured
- 2600 square metres of precast concrete installed

### **Project Milestones**

- New northern build area completed in
  December 2019
- First stage of concourse refurbishment completed including new retail spaces opening 26<sup>th</sup> February 2020
