Virgin Australia announces Adelaide-Bali flights

Adelaide Airport today has welcomed an announcement by Virgin Australia that it will relaunch flights to Bali from December.

The year-round service will initially operate daily from 14 December, offering an additional 2,464 seats per week between Adelaide and Denpasar.

Virgin Australia is offering an Economy Lite sale fare for \$399 return, with tickets available to book now until September 25.

Adelaide Airport Managing Director, Brenton Cox said the airport was delighted to welcome back Virgin Australia flights to Bali.

“We’re approaching the very busy peak holiday period over Christmas / New Year and we know there is significant pent up demand for South Australians wanting to head to holiday destinations such as Bali for the first time in three years,” Mr Cox said.

“It’s exciting to see the relaunch of this route, which represents another big step forward in our COVID recovery. The new service also creates a choice for consumers with Jetstar also operating this route.”

The service will depart Adelaide daily at 5.50pm and arrive in Bali at 8.40pm. The return flight will depart at 10.50pm and arrive in Adelaide at 6.20am.
