Main Runway Closure 21/08/2023 – 01/09/2023

Adelaide Airport would like to advise you that our main runway (runway 05/23) will be closed while we conduct essential survey works in preparation for upcoming runway upgrades. This work will commence on Monday 21 August and will be completed by Friday 1 September during the **existing night curfew** (11pm to 6am).

However, essential maintenance works and main runway closures will continue **periodically until August 2024**, after which normal runway will be used. During this time, the small number of curfew-exempted flights will be utilising the cross runway (runway 12/30) for arrivals and departures.

There are typically up to 10 aircraft movements per night during the curfew hours, the majority of which are emergency services and freight operators. The temporary change in runway use may be noticeable to residents living under the cross runway flight paths to the south-east and north-west of the airport.

We apologise for any disturbance this has caused, and we appreciate your understanding as we undertake these important maintenance works to ensure safe and efficient operation of aircrafts at Adelaide Airport.
