Main Runway Closure 09/01/2024 – 05/04/2024

Adelaide Airport would like to advise you that our main runway (runway 05/23) will be closed while we conduct essential maintenance of asphalt construction works. This work will commence on Tuesday 9 January and will be completed by Friday 5 April 2024 (subject to weather conditions) during the **existing night curfew** (11pm and 6am).

***There will be no works undertaken over public holidays such as Australia Day, Adelaide Cup Day, Easter long weekend and ANZAC Day.**

However, essential maintenance works and main runway closures will continue **periodically until August 2024**, with notifications to the public made available prior to the closures. During this time, the small number of curfew-exempted flights will be utilising the cross runway (runway 12/30) for arrivals and departures.

There are typically up to 10 aircraft movements per night during the curfew hours, the majority of which are emergency services and freight operators. The temporary change in runway use may be noticeable to residents living under the cross runway flight paths to the south-east and north-west of the airport.

We apologise for any disturbance this has caused, and we appreciate your understanding as we undertake these important maintenance works to ensure safe and efficient operation of aircrafts at Adelaide Airport.
