Completion of asphalt overlay on main runway (Runway 05/23) 15/04/2024

Adelaide Airport has completed asphalt overlay on the main runway (Runway 05/23) and will be progressing asphalt works on our taxiways.

Curfew-exempted aircrafts will resume using the main runway from **Monday 15th April** onwards, between 11pm and 6am. Residents living under the light path to the northeast and southwest of Adelaide Airport may again notice aircraft movements throughout the night.

The main runway will be closed again in end May when the asphalt is cured and ready for grooving. Asphalt curing is a crucial process that transforms freshly laid soft asphalt into a hardened, stable surface that allows grooving to occur. Grooving the runway is a safety process that involves cutting shallow channels into the surface to improve tire traction, reduce noise and enhance water drainage.

We appreciate your understanding as we undertake these important works to continue improve our facilities.
