Main Runway Closure 23/05/2024 – 08/2024

Adelaide Airport would like to advise you that our main runway (Runway 05/23) will be closed while we conduct essential grooving works. Grooving the runway is a safety process that involves cutting shallow channels into the surface to improve tire traction, reduce noise and enhance water drainage.

This work will commence on Thursday 23rd May and will be completed by early August 2024 (subject to weather conditions) during the **existing night curfew** (11pm and 6am). During this time, the small number of curfew-exempted flights, majority of which are emergency services and freight operators, will be utilising the cross runway (Runway 12/30). The temporary change in runway use may be noticeable to residents living under the cross runway flight paths to the southeast and northwest of the airport.

Residents living in close proximity of the airport may also experience some construction noise.

***There will be no works undertaken over public holiday such as the King's Birthday.**

We apologise for any disturbance this has caused, and appreciate your understanding as we undertake these important maintenance works to ensure safe and efficient operation of aircrafts at Adelaide Airport.
