Changes to Adelaide Airport ground transport service fee

Adelaide Airport will increase the service fee for taxi and ride-share pick-ups from the airport from \$3 to \$4.50 from February 3, 2025. This is the first increase since 2017.

Adelaide Airport's share of the service fee will be \$4.00 – an increase of \$1 and in line with CPI increases over the past seven years. The South Australian Department for Infrastructure and Transport will receive \$0.50 from each taxi and rideshare trip.

The airport's share of the fee, which only applies to airport pick-ups (not drop-offs), supports ongoing investment in ground transport infrastructure and operational costs at Adelaide Airport. The funding contributes to the provision of facilities and amenities for drivers as well as dedicated infrastructure to help ensure seamless ground transport services for customers leaving the airport. Facilities and services include:

- Layover amenities including kitchen and bathroom facilities for taxi and rideshare drivers; and
- Concierge staff at the airport's taxi rank to assist customers and drivers.

The remaining \$0.50 will fund previously announced industry reform initiatives administered by the State Government.

Adelaide Airport will be spending \$600 million over the next five years to upgrade its terminal and associated infrastructure, including expansion of the check-in area, upgraded security screening and baggage handling systems, new gates and aerobridges and expanding the pick-up and drop-off areas.
