Jetstar adds more than 350,000 new low fares seats to Adelaide network

Tuesday, 2 September 2025: Jetstar will operate up to 13 new domestic flights in and out of Adelaide each week, unlocking more than 350,000 new low fares seats a year on three key domestic routes.

This major capacity increase between Adelaide and Melbourne, Brisbane and Perth will boost domestic capacity for the South Australian capital by 19 per cent when compared to the same time last year.

The growth of Jetstar's Adelaide network means more choice, flexibility and low fares for South Australians heading across the country, while supporting the local tourism industry.

The following increased capacity will be introduced from 26 October 2025:

- Adelaide to Melbourne: From 35 currently up to 40 flights a week (+5).
- Adelaide to Brisbane: From 10 currently up to 14 flights a week (+4).
- Adelaide to Perth: From seven currently up to 11 flights a week (+4).

These flights are available to book now at jetstar.com, with one-way fares currently starting from:

- \$111^ Adelaide to Melbourne
- \$174^ Adelaide to Brisbane
- \$191^ Adelaide to Perth

To support the extra services, Jetstar will base an additional Airbus A320ceo aircraft at Adelaide Airport – increasing the airline's locally based fleet to 6 aircraft.

Comments from Jetstar's Executive Manager, Customer, Jenn Armor:

"We're thrilled to be adding more flights in and out of Adelaide, giving travellers even more low-fare options to Melbourne, Brisbane and Perth.

"This boost in capacity will add more than 350,000 extra seats to our domestic network. It's a huge benefit for the state and a great way to help South Australians take off more on their next trip."

Comments from Adelaide Airport Managing Director, Brenton Cox:

"Jetstar has been an important driver of our recent record passenger numbers. These extra flights and increased capacity will generate even more choice on popular routes. Double daily flights to Brisbane and more flights to Melbourne and Perth are a win for our customers.
